Neosporosis

There is a very interesting article in the Moors Messenger May 2019 about Neosporosis. It says the stick and flick method of disposing of dog poo in the countryside can prove to be deadly to farm animals where cattle and sheep graze or that is cut for cattle feed. Neosporosis is a disease caused by a parasite called *Neospora caninum* which commonly results in abortion and still birth in farm animals.

The parasite reproduces in dogs. Its eggs are produced in the digestive tract, shed in faeces and can remain alive for 6 months. Farm animals consuming contaminated food subsequently become infected..

The National Park authority urges dog owners to always deal with their dogs mess appropriately

BAG IT and put it in a bin.

When to Call 101 - The Police Non-Emergency Number

101 is the number to call when you want to contact North Yorkshire Police when it's less urgent than a 999 call.

When Should I Use 101?

You should call 101 to report crime and other concerns that do not require an *emergency* response. For example, if:

- your quad has been stolen
- your property has been burgled or damaged
- you suspect drug use or dealing in your neighbourhood
- give the police information about crime in your area or to:
- speak to the police about a general enquiry

When you call 101, the system will try to determine your location and connect you to the police force covering that area. As we are so close to the boundary of North Yorkshire Police and Cleveland Police, the system may ask you to confirm which force you are calling.

Who Will Answer My 101 Call?

Calls to 101 are answered by police officers and staff in the North Yorkshire Police Control Room. This ensures that staff with local knowledge can answer and deal with the calls and respond appropriately.

How Much Does It Cost to Call 101?

Calls to 101 (from both landlines and mobile networks) cost 15 pence per call, no matter what time of day you call, or how long you are on the phone.

The 15p cost of the call goes to the telephony providers to cover the cost of carrying the calls. The police and government receive no money from calls to 101.

When Should I Use 999?

You should always call 999 when it is an emergency, such as when a **crime is in progress**, when there is **danger to life** or **when violence is being used or threatened** and/or when somebody suspected of a crime is nearby.
